



## Nitrofurazone Soluble Dressing

### NITROFURAZONE SOLUBLE DRESSING

*A broad antibacterial spectrum ointment that is safe and effective in the treatment of skin wounds such as burns, cutaneous ulcers, skin grafts, donor sites and pyodermas in dogs and horses.*

#### What is it?

*Nitrofurazone Soluble Dressing* (Nitrofurazone 0.2% w/w dissolved in a water-soluble base of polyethylene glycols) is indicated as an aid in the prophylaxis and treatment of superficial bacteria infections sensitive to Nitrofurazone, associated with wounds, burns, cutaneous ulcers, skin grafts, donor sites and for the treatment of pyodermas in dogs and horses.

#### How does it work?

*Nitrofurazone Soluble Dressing* is a synthetic nitrofuran with a broad antibacterial spectrum. It **effectively destroys** most bacteria commonly causing surface infection, including many that have become antibiotic-resistant. It acts by inhibiting enzymes necessary for carbohydrate metabolism in bacteria.

***Nitrofurazone Soluble Dressing has a water-soluble base that can be easily washed out!***

#### Did you know?

*Nitrofurazone Soluble Dressing* impregnated gauze may be covered by waxed paper or petroleum gauze. This may be left intact for five (5) to seven (7) days. Flushing the gauze with saline facilitates removal.



## When and how to apply?

**Wounds and Burns:** Apply directly to the lesions with a spatula, or first place on gauze. Reapply once daily or once weekly, depending on the preferred dressing technique. To avoid adherence by drying of exudates, impregnated gauze may be covered by waxed paper or petroleum gauze.

**Pyodermas:** Apply several times daily with or without a gauze dressing. Use only on abscesses and carbuncles following incision or rupture.

**Ulcers:** Varicose and decubitus ulcers may be treated as are wounds and lesions. However, in chronic cases, it is advisable to protect the abnormally sensitive skin about the lesion with zinc oxide ointment or paste. Restricting application to five (5) to seven (7) days where feasible minimizes irritation and sensitization. It is effective only when bacterial infection is responsible for lack of healing.

**Skin Grafts:** The dressing is used both to prepare burns and other lesions for grafting, and postoperatively as a prophylactic measure. By rapid eradication of the infection, it can produce clean, firm granulation tissue. Because it is water-soluble and has negligible tissue toxicity, it does not interfere with successful takes. To avoid adherence on the bandage, an ointment impregnated gauze may be covered by waxed paper or petroleum gauze.
